Term 2 School Photos

As mentioned in earlier newsletters, Mater Christi will be working with 3P Photography for our 2018 school photos. <u>Our school photos will commence on Wednesday 2nd May, Week 1 (Term 2).</u> This week your child(ren) will have been sent home with an Order Form to be completed during the school holidays. It is essential that <u>each child</u> hand this completed Order Form to the photographers, prior to having their individual photo taken. This is a different process to how our photos operated in previous years, and we greatly appreciate your support with this. In addition, we ask that children from Year 1-6 are dressed in **full winter uniform** (including a tie for those in Year 4-6). Children in Pre-Primary will wear their faction sports uniform, whilst the Kindy children are encouraged to wear their Kindy top.

Should you wish to order a family photo, photographers will be available before and after school, as well as during recess and lunch breaks. Where possible, we encourage parents to accompany their children to the before and after school sessions as 3P do not remove students during class time. If this is a concern for you, please notify the office by no later than Tuesday 1st May, so that alternate arrangements can be made.
