



An Easter Breakfast

"Come and have breakfast," says the risen Jesus in John's Gospel as He builds a charcoal fire, cooks a fish breakfast on the beach for His disciples, and breaks bread with them (Jn 21:1-14). Once again, a meal becomes a powerful occasion for love, forgiveness and transformation. Perhaps your family can think up a creative way to share breakfast together during this season of Easter. A wonderful way to put the living Christ at the centre of our homes is to make the most of family meals, giving thanks as we break bread together.

Pray: Read the story of "breakfast on the beach" (Jn 21:1-14) as a family as you share a meal of grilled fish (Fish fingers is a quick & easy version!)

Act: Make the most of sunny skies before winter sets in. Get outdoors as a family and walk, run, play, fish or picnic together.

Remember: Important things can happen over a simple shared meal.

I would especially like to thank:


- Marie and Gavin Fernandes for welcoming us to their home and trusting us to get the work done.


Allergy Awareness


Mater Christi Backyard Blitz



The Staff at Mater Christi have wholeheartedly embraced this year's Team Building Day project with gusto and community spirit assisting a well deserving Parish family in cleaning up and beautifying their front yard. When the school advertised their Backyard Blitz Team Building initiative to the Community, we received a nomination from another Parishioner for a very humble family who really needed help. Marie and Gavin Fernandes have been Parishioners at Mater Christi Church for nearly 20 years and have three sons all of whom have attended Mater Christi and Emmanuel Catholic College. Marie suffers from a crippling arthritis condition which sees her wheelchair bound and unable to walk let alone maintain their large corner block. The family have endured incredible financial hardship over the past few years due to the downturn in the mining industry which left husband

Gavin unemployed and having to seek any work to provide for their family. Whilst Marie doesn't complain and is actively involved in the Catechist after school program and acts as a Safeguarding Officer at Mater Christi Church, husband Gavin often drives other Parishioners to their medical appointments waiting hours with them and refusing to take any payment.
