JUST ONE DRIVE THROUGH CHANGE - FROM TUESDAY 2 JUNE

Due to the increased pressure on Drive Through, Yangebup Rd, Dunraven Drive and Osprey Drive, including the impact on residents we are reverting back to ONLY families with students in Years 2-6 have access to drive through and all other families are to park and collect their children from the appropriate oval gate. I cannot express in words how much time and effort morning drop off and afternoon pick up has consumed our lives and everyone's patience. This has been and continues to be an EPIC journey for all of us and I sincerely thank you for your continued understanding, patience, smiles and waves. Thank you for your ongoing encouragement when dropping off and picking up your children. The staff truly appreciate your support.

One of the hardest aspects at the moment is that we can't have parents, grandparents and carers onsite at school. Not having parents onsite really goes against what we do here at Mater Christi. I hope that we can welcome families back at school very soon.

FAMILIES WITH CHILDREN in Kindy, Pre-Primary and Year One; including siblings in Years 2-6:

- Turn into Pelican Ramble from Osprey Drive then on to Pioneer Drive and left into Yangebup Road
- Enter main car park of the school
- Reverse park in carpark and overflow on top oval (NB: There is further parking alongside and behind the Community Centre)
- For drop off walk your child/ren to the Kindy/PP/Year One Gates (OVAL SIDE). The gates will be open at 8.15am
- For pick up collect children holding your Family Name Card from K/PP/Yr 1 Gates (OVAL SIDE)
- Drop off siblings in Years 2-6 go to Year One Gate
- Pick up siblings in Years 2-6 go to gate of youngest sibling
- · Parents are to maintain physical distancing at pick up and drop off
- Once children are collected, drive around the Community Centre and out the front gate
- Turn right into Pioneer Drive

Please be advised that access to Osprey Rd directly via Yangebup Rd will not be possible during these times.

FAMILIES WITH CHILDREN in Years 2-6 ONLY will be asked to use the normal drive through as follows:

- Enter Yangebup Road
- Turn right into Drive Through (normal drive through procedure)
- Exit drive through onto Yangebup Road

PLEASE BE MINDFUL NOT TO BLOCK THE DRIVEWAYS OF DIVINE MERCY
