This week's Gospel echoes an elevation of God's servant, Simon Peter, who Jesus bestows the name Peter, the rock on which he builds his Church. Peter is not given the keys of an earthly authority, but the keys of the kingdom of heaven for "whatever you bind on earth shall be considered bound in heaven and whatever you loose on earth shall be considered loose in heaven." Peter was being called to be more than just the Chief Rabbi in the pilgrim church, he was being called to be the one to open to others eternal life.

What is our lesson from this Gospel on eternal life? What are we being called to do?

#### **Making Jesus Real**



All you need to get involved in the School Banking program is a Commonwealth Bank Youthsaver account. You can open an account for your child in one of two ways:

#### 1. Online

Visit **commbank.com.au/schoolbanking** and click on the link to open a Youthsaver account.

#### 2. In branch

Visit a Commonwealth Bank branch with identification for yourself and your child, like a driver's licence and Birth Certificate.

If your child has an existing Commonwealth Bank Youthsaver account, they can start banking straight away. They just need to bring their deposit in every week on School Banking day using their Dollarmites deposit wallet. #### **Science Week**

This week was National Science Week! At Mater Christi, students competed in different challenges depending on their year level. Year 2-4 worked hard to build a bridge more than 30cm long to hold the most weight and the Year 5 and 6 classes built a catapult to launch a domino the furthest distance. Each group only had 15-25 minutes to build their design. This year the prizes were a more sustainable option – a small envelope of seeds and some biodegradable pots. All students competed in the fun-filled lesson with enthusiasm and great sportsmanship, even in the face of heartbreak (e.g. catapults
