by the Holy Spirit of Freedom Community.






Happy Birthday to our Beautiful Church


Well done to the Senior Choir and Vocal Ensemble for being awarded a Certificate of Excellence at the Performing Arts Festival in Primary Choral Singing.

Science Week



Love, Sex & Relationships: There is a critical need for abuse prevention education for teenagers. Last year the Safeguarding Team released a handbook for parents of younger children, this year the Team has produced a handbook for older children and teens.

The new Teenagers Resource will be launched at the Child Protection Breakfast and a **workshop** for parents and carers of older children and teens will be held at **Mater Christi Parish Hall at 7:00pm on Thursday 6 September**.

Whilst the resource speaks directly to teenagers, the workshop speaks directly to parents to assist them with guiding their teens as they work through the various topics (we call them basket fillers) in the resource so that they can have accurate information and prevention skills. The workshop is free and all participants will receive a copy of the "Love, Sex & Relationships" resource.
