

Due to the wear and tear the oval parking area will be closed for some time to allow the grass to replenish and grow.




## **ATOM Photography Competition K-6**

Be creative with your photography, and feel free to think outside the box when addressing the theme. Your photographs can be colour or black-and-white, realistic or abstract; they






## **About ATOM**

## **Safeguarding Project**



The Archdiocesan Safeguarding Project is Archbishop Timothy Costello's response to the tragic stories that have been revealed at the Royal Commission into Institutional Child Abuse. In an effort to prevent such horrible deeds happening again, all Parishes now have Safeguarding Officers who maintain a presence in the Parish and have been trained as a first point of contact for children and vulnerable adults who are experiencing abuse or have concerns along these lines. Officers are responsible for evaluating Parish activities and implementing practices to keep our children safe.

Child Protection Week is in the first week of September and more information will be provided in this newsletter over the next few weeks. We will also be looking at what the community can do such as teaching our children protective behaviours to help them stay safe.

As a first step we are running a competition to help our children become more aware of needing to feel safe and to be safe. Students have been asked to create an A3 poster on the theme "God gave all children the right to feel safe at all times". First prize is a new iPad donated by The Record. The winning poster will also become the official Archdiocesan Child Protection poster.

Students can pick up an entry form from Reception. Entries are due by Saturday August 19 and can be left at Reception for collection by one of the Safeguarding Officers, Donna Johnson or Ilonka Heinzle.
