

And when the son begins to give his practiced speech of repentance, the father interrupts him and shouts orders to begin the celebration. Jesus is telling us that this is how God feels about our Reconciliation. It isn't about us having to shame ourselves or face being scolded. It is all about letting ourselves receive the merciful and healing love and peace that only God's love can give us.

Both girls were awarded 'Player of the tournament' at the National Youth Championships in Coffs Harbour and at the NTC Challenge at the AIS Canberra this year. Tijan attended camps at the AIS and was one of the youngest selected into the Junior Matildas squad to fly to Kyrgyz Republic to play in the Asian Football Confederation U16 Women's Championship Qualifiers, making her debut and scoring a penalty.
