Dear Parents and Caregivers

I recently came across the refection below and so I share it with you. I believ has a powerful message.

A 43-year-old woman was reflecting on the importance of her relationship with mother in establishing self-image. She vividly remembered when she was while playing with her toys in the living-room – a place she had been caution about because her mother had placed there a large and beautiful vase, it was family heirloom.

As she was playing she bumped the stand the vase sat on. It shook and the v tumbled to the wooden floor with a very loud crash and broke into many piece The child was very frightened and cried out – not only out of her fear but beca she knew the importance of the vase to her mother.

When she screamed her mother ran into the room, saw what had happened and immediately hugged the child. Her mother soothed her and the first words were: "I am so glad you are all right. When you screamed I was afraid you were hurt." Now at the age of 43, looking back on that story, the woman who is now herself a mother said: "I learned that day that I was the family treasure."


Sr Emmanuel

The Sacrament of Reconciliation is God's gift to us. In the story of the Prodigal Son, Jesus tries to tell us that God is simply waiting for us to "come home." In the story, the father is not only waiting, he is out by the road longing for the wayward son to return. And when the son begins to give his practiced speech of repentance, the father interrupts him and shouts orders to begin the celebration. Jesus is telling us that this is how God feels about our Reconciliation. It isn't about us having to shame ourselves or face being scolded. It is all about letting ourselves receive the merciful and healing love and peace that only God's love can give us.
