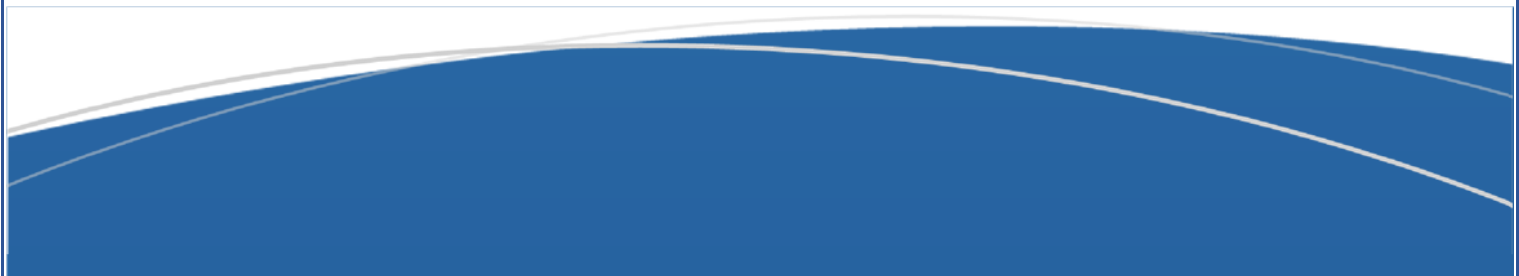

Board Newsletter Report - November 2017

PRINCIPAL REVIEW

You would be aware that our Principal, Miss Toni Kalat was reviewed under the Principal Review Process this year. The process involved the School Board, P&F Executive, the Parish Priest, Staff Members, Catholic Education personnel and the Principal. Their input was both in written form and verbally through interviews with the Review Panel. The review culminated in a meeting between the Principal and the Acting Executive Director of the Catholic Education Western Australia, Dr Debra Sayce.

The process has now been completed and Archbishop Timothy Costelloe has endorsed the appointment of Miss Toni Kalat as Principal of Mater Christi Catholic Primary School, Yangebup for a second contract period of five years.

As a result of the review, Toni has developed a professional growth plan which will ensure her continued development and benefit the future of the school.

On behalf of the School Board and the Mater Christi Catholic Primary School community, I congratulate Toni on her achievements over the last contract period and look forward to the future.

SCHOOL IMPROVEMENT PLAN

The Capital Development Plan Team (CDP) have been meeting with our selected architects (Parry & Rosenthal Architects) on a very regular basis over the past few weeks. It was exciting to receive the first draft of our Master Plan just prior to the AGM this week and finally get a visual picture on what the future holds for our wonderful school community. The CDP team will continue to work alongside the architects as we now begin to look at how this plan will be delivered and the actual time frames for these projects.

Not much to add to the ongoing consultation in relation to the oval development. The board continues to communicate with the Cockburn Council in the hope that the January council meetings will provide greater direction as to what we can achieve together in the future.

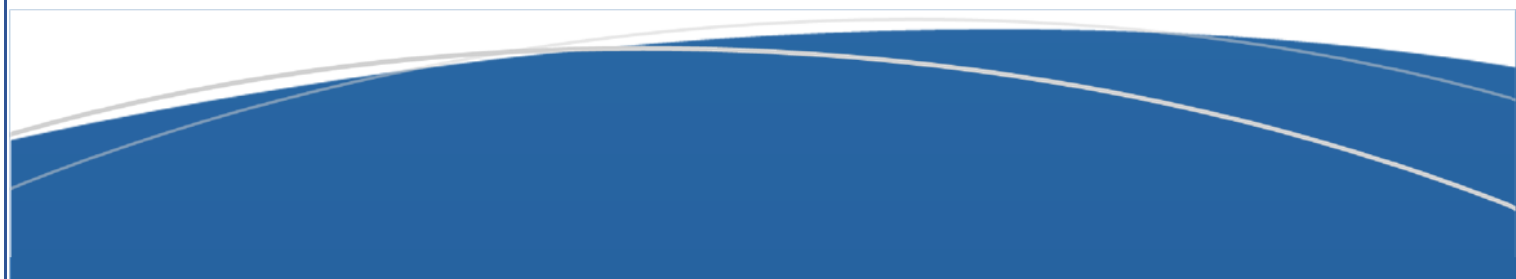

Flameless candles will be on sale for **\$3.00** so that everyone can join in the festivities.

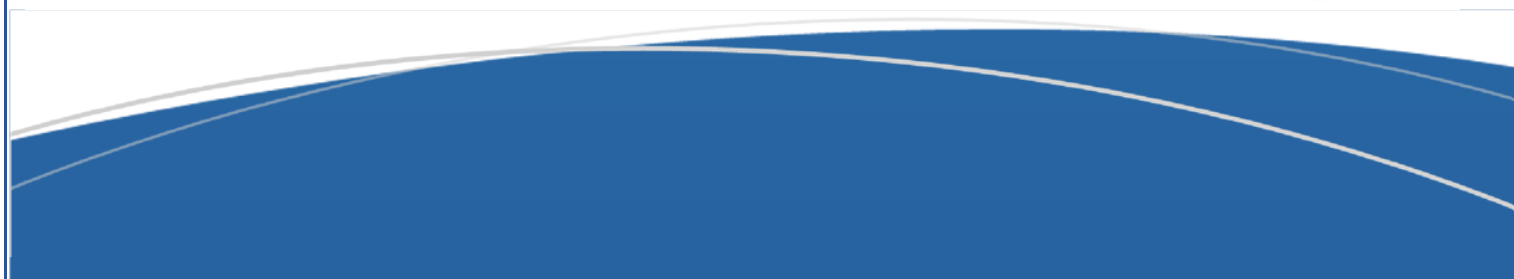

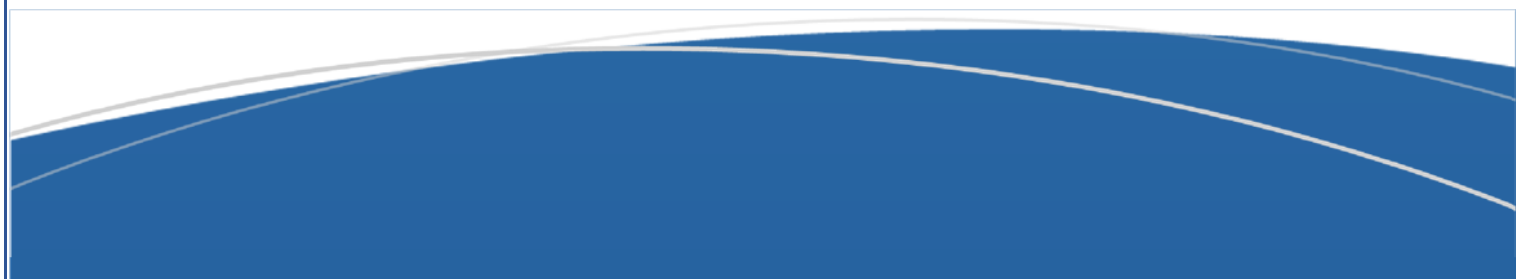

PRE-PRIMARY CAR PARK CLOSED FOR FOOD TRUCKS

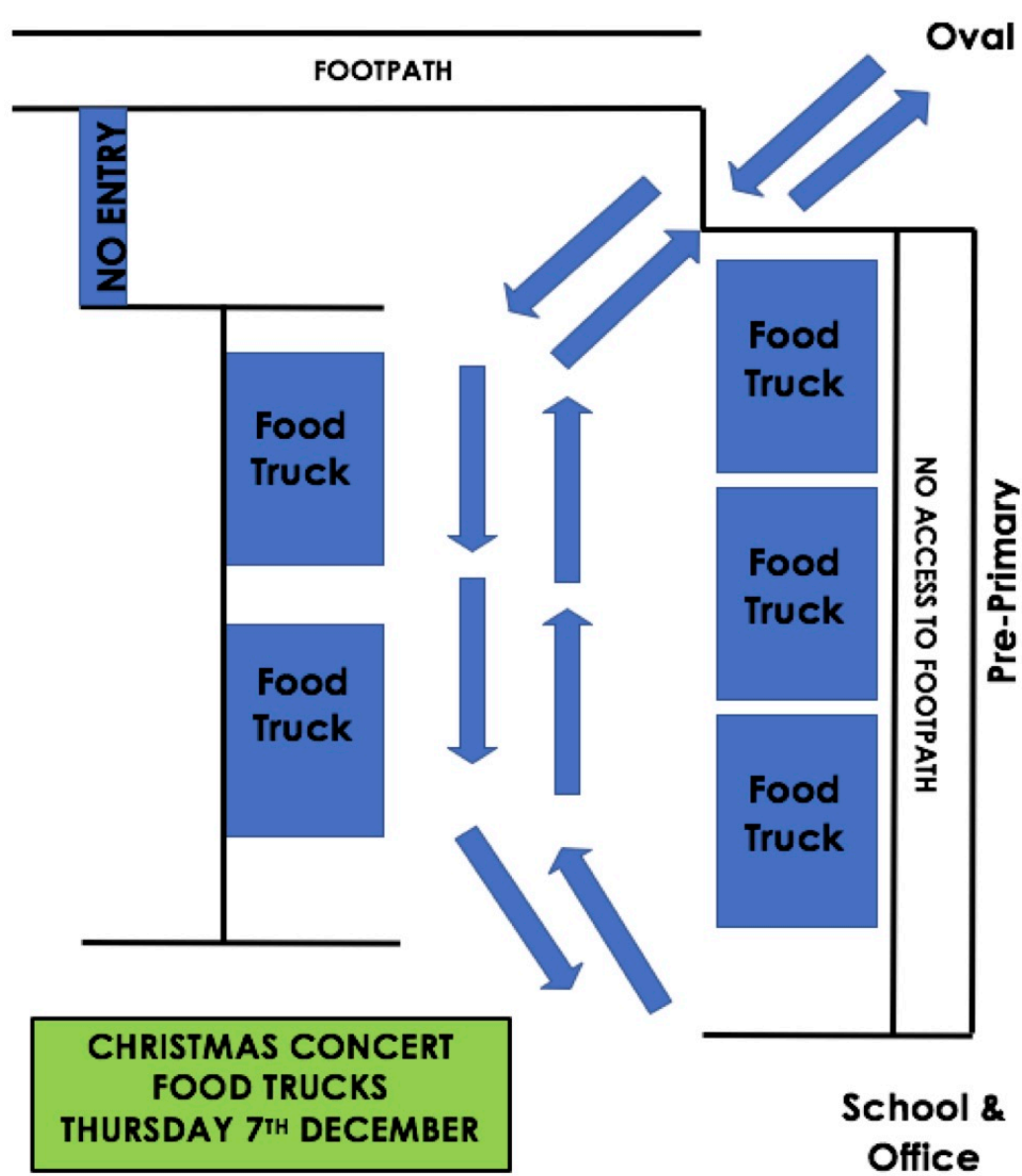
On **Thursday the 7th December** (Christmas Concert Night), a variety of **Food Trucks** will be available from 4.00-6.00pm.

Lessons will begin in Week 2, Term 1 2018. Students will be notified of their lesson day by the end of Week 1 by their tutor.

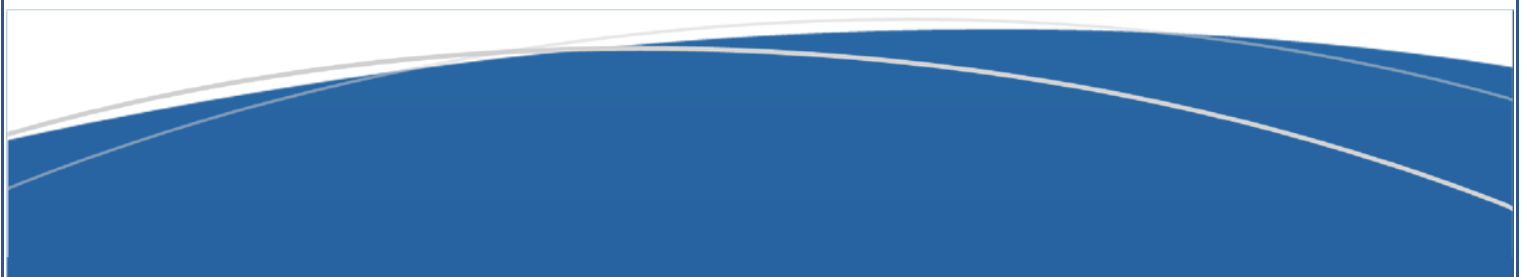
