

First Week of Advent

This Sunday we commence the Church's Season of Advent. Whilst there have been Christmas decorations in the shops for weeks now, it is important that we remember why we have Christmas in the first place. Advent is a time of preparation, hope and waiting for the birth of Jesus.



It is a story that we know well. Basically, Mary said 'Yes', to the angel Gabriel – but what was she saying yes to?

This is an amazing story of unconditional faith and trust. An angel visits a Jewish girl. She is to be married to Joseph in the near future. The angel comes to her and says that she will give birth to a baby, not any baby, but the Son of God. By saying yes, she is risking becoming an outcast by Joseph and his community. But she says yes – yes to giving birth to Jesus. And as we have said many times in the Hail Mary,

"Blessed is the fruit of your womb, Jesus"!

This story tells us about faith and trust. With God, all things are possible. God is beyond our understanding and we need to trust in God, and have faith. Mary, who would have been frightened with the angel's appearance, does not totally understand God's ways, but says "Let what you have said be done".

We too do not understand God's ways, but our faith calls us to believe in God.
