Religious Education

3rd Week of Lent – Project Compassion – brings you Uncle Richard's story

First Australian Uncle Richard is a survivor of the Stolen Generations, forcibly removed from his family as a child and taken to Kinchela Boys Home (KBH) in NSW. Hundreds of Indigenous boys were incarcerated there between 1924 and 1970, suffering ongoing physical and verbal abuse. They lost every aspect of their identity – their names, their culture and their families.



When Uncle Richard left KBH, he struggled with the legacy of pain, trying to find relief through his work as an artist. But he attributes the beginning of his healing to something even more powerful than his creative work, his reconnection with former KBH boys.

The KBH Aboriginal Corporation (KBHAC) was established by KBH survivors to reunite with one another and begin healing. KBHAC's Unlocking the Past to Free the Future Program works to restore the social and emotional wellbeing of the survivors and their families. The former KBH boys have realised that their shared suffering has created a brotherhood. They support each other by sharing their stories, and coming to a common understanding of how their experiences have impacted on themselves and their descendants.

Through KBHAC, the men are also opening the door to the wider Australian community, inviting everyone to journey together as neighbours in the healing process. Caritas Australia supports KBHAC and is proud to walk alongside in partnership on the journey to wellbeing.

Class Photos/Portraits:

- Every Student will have their photo taken, whether they are purchasing photos or not, for the schools pictorial history.
- The school has chosen to use the online ordering system. Your child has been given
 an online ordering instruction slip and a unique student code for you to follow
 and place you order online via the internet.
- The expiry date for online ordering is the **06.04.2017** (students last day of Term One). Any orders received after this date are treated as re orders and will incur additional costs.

Family Photos:

- Envelopes can be obtained from Administration as well as a sign in form to record student details (names and classes).
- Family photos are being taken on Friday morning before school, as well as during allocated time slots throughout the two photo days.
- Please ensure that your family envelope with enclosed payment is handed to the Photographers on photo day.

Special/Sports Group Photos:

- If your child is in a Special/Sports photo you will receive a link and password to the online gallery after photo day, where you can view and order these photos if required. These photos will be packed and delivered with the school's bulk order.
- Sports captains will be required to come to school dressed in their sports uniform, including their faction colour shirt for their photo on Thursday morning. Captains will then need to change into their summer uniform in preparation for class photos that afternoon.

Uniform Shop News

Attention all year one students (especially girls) and all NEW students in the school.

In term two and three our school students are required to wear Winter Uniform.

For the boys this will mean you will require a school Jumper and Trousers (not compulsory).

For the girls it will mean you will need a Yellow Shirt, Winter Skirt and Jumper with either navy stockings or the school navy socks. If your child is a senior (year four - six) they will be required to wear a tie too.

On **Thursday March 23rd** I will schedule appointments for your convenience to try on uniforms.

A timetable is currently displayed on the Uniform Shop window for you to write your child's name alongside your preferred time to attend. As is stated on the timetable, due to tight scheduling, you must have collected your child from his/her class PRIOR to your allocated time and BE AT THE UNIFORM SHOP for your appointment time, otherwise the system will not work efficiently.

Please be aware that the appointments are only 15 minutes, so please come ready to QUICKLY try-on the uniform.

As a courtesy to other parents, I ask that you please <u>do</u> <u>not bring your child into the uniform shop for</u> <u>fittings during peak times</u>, which are between 8:15 - 8:40am and 2:50 - 3:20pm as this does take time and delays other customers.

If you wish to purchase without fitting, please use the online Uniform Ordering system that you can find on the Mater Christi web site. Alternatively, you may wish to complete an order form available from the office, and send it to school with cash in an envelope marked "Uniform Shop" or fill in your credit card details and leave at the office for myself to collect. Your order will then be processed and sent to your child's class room for them to take home.

Thank you for your co-operation and I look forward to seeing many of you in the Uniform Shop over the coming weeks.

How To Install Skoolbag On Your Smartphone

For iPhone and iPad users:

- 1. Click the "App Store" icon on your Apple device.
- 2. Type your school name in the search, using suburb name will help.
- 3. You will see your school appear, click "Get" then "install".
- The app is FREE to download.
- When installed click "Open"
- 6. Select "OK" to receive push notifications, when asked.
- 7. Click the "More" button on the bottom right of the App, then "Setup".
- 8. Toggle on the Push Categories that are applicable for you by tapping the on/off switch.



For Android users:

You must first have signed up with a Google Account before installing the app.

- 1. Click the "Play Store" button on your Android Device
- Click the magnifying glass icon at the top and type in your school name, using suburb name will help.
- 3. Click the school name when it appears in the search.
- 4. Click the "Install" button.
- Click "Accept" for various permissions (please note, we do not modify any of your personal data on your device).
- Click "Open" when installed.
- 7. Click the "More" button on the bottom right of the App, then "Setup".
- 8. Toggle on the Push Categories that are applicable for you by tapping the on/off switch.

Please Note: Some brands of Android phones need the setting in "Notification Manager" changed to "Allow" instead of "Notify" in order for the push notifications to work. The phone must also be running at least version 4 system software to run the app.



For Windows 81 Phone and Windows 81 or 10 device users:

- 1. Go to the Windows Store on your 81 Windows Phone or Windows 81/10 Device
- 2. Search for "Skoolbag" in the keyword app search
- 3. Install the Skoolbag app
- 4. Find your school either by using the keyword search or location service.
- 5. Click the "Pin" icon to pin the school tile to your Windows Phone home screen.
- 6. Click the "More" button on the bottom right of the App, then "Setup"
- Toggle the Push Categories that are applicable to you by tapping the on/off switch.

Please Note: The Skoolbag Windows App is for 81 version Windows Phones, or Windows 81 and 10 devices.
