It's an important time in the Indigenous calendar to celebrate and promote our culture.

Last Friday, Mater Christi students from Pre-Primary-Six, took part in three various activities to learn about the Indigenous culture.

Students were invited to complete sand painting, Yonga (kangaroo) hunting and a talk with Indigenous consultant and Nyoongar culture specialist Leonard Thorn.

The NAIDOC theme this year was 'We all stand on sacred ground', a belief that is paramount to Indigenous belief and culture. Overall the day was met with willingness to learn and to engage.

A special thank you to Leonard Thorn for sharing his knowledge with us and to our special guest Robyn Collard for coming and blessing our NAIDOC celebration with a 'Welcome to Country'.

Our clinics are coordinated and run by Physical Education and/or BBB Specialists; all with their Working With Children Checks. The Clinic focuses on **Maximum Participation** during **Organised** and **Fun** 8 \times 1 Hour sessions. The cost for the term is \$80.00 per child.
