Book Week and Mater Christi Literacy Week



During Child Protection Week in September, the Safeguarding Office in partnership with the Protective Behaviour WA will be hosting a series of Protective Behaviour Workshops.

Our Parish is lucky enough to be one of the parishes to host a workshop.

One way in which parents can assist in increasing their child's safety is by teaching them the protective behaviours program.

These workshops, have been designed to teach parents and cares how to increase the personal safety of their children. Whilst there are many ways of talking to children about their personal safety, it is important that we do not scare them or leave them feeling unsafe, afraid or disempowered.

Our workshop will be held on Thursday the 8th of September from 7pm-9pm. It is for parents only, no children. We strongly recommend that you attend. If you cannot attend this night, please consider going to a workshop at another location. Registration forms can be found in the foyer of church.


