SWIMMING LESSONS 2015

As part of the Physical Education programme, all children in Years One to Six will be attending *compulsory* swimming lessons at the Riverton Leisureplex beginning on Monday 23rd November and concluding Friday 4th December 2015. This Year all classes from Year One to Year Six will have ten 35min lessons.

Students will be bused to and from the Riverton Leisureplex under the supervision of their class teachers. Lessons will be conducted by qualified instructors, using the Royal Lifesaving Vacswim stages.

Each child is required to have bathers (worn under uniform to school each day), a towel and a pair of slip-on footwear (to be worn to and from the pool only) for each lesson. Goggles are optional, but highly recommended. All items are to be carried to and from the pool in a clearly labelled swimming or plastic bag.

PLEASE clearly label every item of clothing including bathers, towel, goggles, shoes, socks and underwear. We cannot be responsible for lost items of clothing.

Please complete the enrolment form for each child (sent home this week) and return it to your child's class teacher by Friday 13th November. Please note that both sections must be completed and signed. Any difficulties regarding attendance of lessons should be sent in writing, with an attached medical certificate, to the Principal.

The students are not allowed to wear thongs / flip flops to school.

Children will change into their slip-on footwear before they leave for the pool and put their uniform footwear on when they return to school.

Blood is a life-changing donation more powerful than money because saving a life is something you can't put a price on!

Mater Christi Catholic Primary School is now registered as part of the **Red25** group. This is a united group of blood donors across Australia who has joined the movement with the aim of providing 25% of all the blood donations required in Australia across the year.

This life-saving social responsibility programme as part of **The Australian Red Cross Blood Service** is recognising that a small gesture on your behalf can combine with those of others to make a big difference to our whole community.

Currently, only 1 in 30 Australians give blood, but 1 in 3 Australians will need blood in their lifetime.

To join the Mater Christi Catholic Primary School group and you're already an existing donor, this is your link: www.donateblood.com.au/who-can-give/red25/join-group.

If you want to donate but are not yet a registered blood donor, call 13 14 95 to get your ID – it only takes a few minutes.

Red25 members don't need to donate at the same time as others to contribute to our overall tally, every time members give blood it's automatically counted towards the tally. If you want to get together with a group of 3 or 4, transport can be arranged to our local centre down in South Fremantle.
