Parking and Traffic Flow around the School

Below is a reminder about our Parking and Traffic rules to ensure the safety of our children at all times. We ask for you to exercise patience and caution.

- The first driveway with green arrows is 'drive-through' and is for pick-up and drop-off only. Overtaking in the 'drive-through' to get to the back of the school is potentially dangerous. If there is a need to gain access to that area, drivers must wait in the queue.
- The second driveway with blue arrows is for parking, and getting out of the car to walk in to the school to collect children. This area has an 8km speed limit.
- Please be courteous to others and allow them the time to 'Reverse park'.
- Stopping or double parking is not permitted. Please only park your vehicle in a designated parking bay.
- Please do not ask children to wait for you at the front of the school or on the oval. They are to wait in the undercover area where they are supervised.
- The 'Baby Bays' are for the use by parents/guardians with prams.

SWIMMING LESSONS 2015

As part of the Physical Education programme, **all** children in **Years One to Six** will be attending **compulsory** swimming lessons at the Riverton Leisureplex beginning on **Monday 23rd November and concluding Friday 4th December 2015.** This Year all classes from Year One to Year Six will have ten 35min lessons.

Students will be bused to and from the Riverton Leisureplex under the supervision of their class teachers. Lessons will be conducted by qualified instructors, using the Royal Lifesaving Vacswim stages.

Each child is required to have bathers (worn under uniform to school each day), a towel and a pair of slip-on footwear (**to be worn to and from the pool only**) for each lesson. Goggles are optional, but highly recommended. All items are to be carried to and from the pool **in a clearly labelled swimming or plastic bag.**

PLEASE <u>clearly label</u> every item of clothing including bathers, towel, goggles, shoes, socks and underwear. We cannot be responsible for lost items of clothing.

Please complete the enrolment form for <u>each child</u> (sent home this week) and return it to your child's class teacher by <u>Friday 13</u>th <u>November</u>. Please note that both sections must be completed and signed. Any difficulties regarding attendance of lessons should be sent in writing, with an attached medical certificate, to the Principal.

The students are not allowed to wear thongs / flip flops to school.

Children will change into their slip-on footwear before they leave for the pool and put their uniform footwear on when they return to school.
